DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal Sammamish Plateau Water and Sewer District 2003 Wastewater Comprehensive Plan.

Proponent Sammamish Plateau Water and Sewer District Engineering Department.

Location of proposal, including street address, if any Within the existing and future sewer service areas of the Sammamish Plateau Water and Sewer District. This covers approximately 25 square miles and includes the urban area generally bounded by Lake Sammamish on the West, the Snoqualmie Valley on the East, I-90 on the south and the Redmond-Fall City Road on the north, except for the area in the Northeast Sammamish Sewer and Water District generally north of NE 16th and west of 238th Avenue NE (if extended). The sewer service area includes much of the City of Sammamish, the northeast section of the City of Issaquah and unincorporated King County.

Lead Agency Sammamish Plateau Water and Sewer District

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
